

Weather Disruption – Saturday, 25 January 2025

As Storm Eowyn is forecast to continue affecting weather throughout Scotland on Saturday, 25 January, Loganair has proactively cancelled services to Kirkwall and Sumburgh.

The following scheduled services have been cancelled due to the high winds forecast:

While the forecast for the Hebrides looks disruptive, conditions are expected to ease as the day progresses. Therefore, the following services are expected to operate on a revised schedule as follows:

- LM471: Stornoway-Glasgow (Scheduled time of departure: 08:30)
 - **Revised time of departure: 15:05**
